

## Vaccinations Required for Boarding

When coming to camp, many families are here at any given time. Here at Ms C's we usually have about 35 different families visiting at one time. The suites are in close proximity to each other. Proper vaccinations is essential in decreasing the risk of passing on infections. Vaccinations stimulate the dog's body to produce antibodies to specific contagious and often lethal diseases. At Ms C's we require up to date vaccination records for all dogs entering the facility, whether it be day camp, boarding, grooming or just a tour.

If your dog comes in to contact with a disease they are vaccinated against the antibodies will protect them. Immunity after vaccination may take days or weeks to develop afterwards. Safety of our guest is of utmost importance. Here at Ms C's we require **Rabies, Bordetella, DHLPP (Distemper-Hepatitis-Leptospirosis-Para influenza & Parvovirus)** and **Canine Influenza (H3N8& H3N2)**. Most dogs receive these vaccinations as puppies and then further booster vaccinations throughout their lives. Some vaccinations need annual boosters others have a three-year life. If your dog has not been vaccinated before or is overdue vaccinations, they cannot be boarded in kennels until 7-14 days after vaccination. Proof of a negative fecal test is also required.

Like other reputable dog resorts we require written and current proof of vaccinations before your dog can be boarded with us. This proof must come directly from your veterinarian. This is for the protection of all of our guest.
